

## **Report of Internal Quality Assurance Cell Session 2012-13**

The college is devoted to the overall development of the students so that it may lead to their holistic development enabling them to contribute positively to society and to the nation as responsible citizens. During the academic session 2012-13 every effort was made to mark a new milestone in the history of the college and to lead the college further in the direction and the mission with which the college has been set up.

The faculty of the college remained active all the year round to see that the interests of the students are not ignored and they get what they deserve. Various societies formed by the college conducted meetings, workshops, extension lectures, rallies and other competitions to motivate and to develop the latent potentialities of the students and to establish regular interaction with them which is so necessary for the healthy development of the asset of the nation. The details of the activities conducted by various cell /societies/ clubs etc. have been given for reference in brief.

### **Grievances Redressal Cell**

The college has formed a Grievances Redressal Cell to redress the problems of the students and to create a healthy atmosphere in the college by organizing regular students-parents-teachers and Panch, sarpanches meet. Three different meetings of the students Arts, Commerce and Science faculty were held on 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2012 to take their feedback on the curricula and the infrastructure available in the college. A parents-teachers meeting was held on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2012. A meeting of sarpanches of nearby villages, S.D.M. and B.D.O I&II was held on 31<sup>th</sup> October 2012 to apprise them the plans and programmes being implemented in the college. Three different meetings of the students of Arts, Commerce and science faculties were called on 19<sup>th</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> March to take their feedback about the curricula, courses covered in the classes and the performance of the teachers. A meeting of parents-teachers and some distinguished persons of the area was organized on 25<sup>th</sup> march, 2013 to apprise them the progress and lecture shortage of their wards.

### **Women and Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell**

The cell convened meetings of girls students, arranged lectures on the topics related to women empowerment, common problems faced by women in college and working places and their solutions. A complaint and suggestion box has been installed in girl's common room to facilitate them to put their suggestions and to lodge their complaints. The cell also took cases of harassment of girls by the boys and solved them amicably.

### **S.C./ S.T/ B.C./ Minorities Cell**

The cell has been constituted to look after the welfare of the students of S.C/S.T/B.C/ minorities. The students of these categories were guided about the various welfare schemes launched by the government and the college. The cell of the college remained active all the year round to see that the interests of these students are not ignored. The cell has also established a separate library for these students to provide free books for the whole year. A large number of students availed the benefit of it.

### **Legal literacy Cell**

A legal literacy cell has been formed in the college in collaboration with Haryana State Legal Services Authority and Haryana Education Department to provide legal literacy to the students. It organized various competitions like essay writing, slogan writing, poster making, on the spot painting debate etc. to provide awareness to the students about the legal complications in their day to day life. Our students Jyoti sangwan and Navin kumar won prizes in district level legal literacy programme.

### **Voter Enrollment cell**

As per directions of Election Commission and the district administration, Voter Enrolment Cell has been created in the college. The cell has started a special drive to awaken the students for the enrolment of fresh voter with the result that the forms of 240 students who have attained the age of 18 year were forwarded to the district election office Bhiwani for registering their names in voter list Apart from this many competition like debate, Slogan writing, poster making etc were organized to generate the interests of the students in the election process. An awareness rally was also organized on the occasion of Voter Day on 25/1/13 in the city of Charkhi Dadri to awaken the masses about the role of voters in democratic government.

### **Wall Magazine Club**

A wall magazine section has been set up in the college to develop and to promote creativity among the students of the College. A large number of students contributed their articles, Slogans on current issues, paintings, cartoons and cuttings of the paper etc. The result is that a crowd of students can be seen in front of wall magazine section all the time.

### **Sports Dept**

The college having its own stadium and gymnasium provides adequate sports facilities to the students of the college. During the session 2012-13, 17 teams comprising of about 280 students were sent to participate in various inter-college tournaments conducted by Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak. Some of our students showed extraordinary performance, won medals and represented M.D. University in all India Inter – University Tournaments. Our woman athlete Nirmala of B.A. II won gold medal in Junior Asian Track & field championship and represented India in Junior World Athletic Championship held at Moscow. She also won gold medal in 400 mt. race in All India Inter-University Athletic Championship held at Kalyani. Our other women athlete Sharmila won Silver medal in Javelin throw in All India Inter-University Athletic Championship. It is also worth mentioning that the Best Athlete title in both the sections of Men and Women in M.D. University Inter-College Athletic championship went to our students Bharthari and Nirmala respectively Bharthari won the award for second year consecutively. He won gold medal in Junior National Athletics also. Moreover nine students of our college represented M.D. University in Various Inter – University games.

### **Drama and Music Club**

The Drama and Music club of the college has been most popular among the students and keeps on adding colors in the atmosphere of the college. The club keeps on organizing, various contests like debates, poetic recitation competitions, quizzes, skits, and musical programmes. Our students also participate in various competitions organized by other colleges, universities and state govt. Our students like Jyoti Sangwan, Ankit Raj, Abhishek Jain, Jitender, Arun etc. won commendable positions in various state level competitions and in zonal and inter zonal youth festivals.

### **Community Development & welfare services**

Three units of NSS one for girls and two for boys, N.C.C. and Youth Red Cross Club have been working in the college. These units remained active all the year round for community development and welfare services by organizing various camps, Janchetna Rally and other programs. During the session these organizations organized Tree Plantation Program, Blood Donation Camp, AIDS awareness rally, youth day, swachta Chetna rally, World Environment Day, Adult Education campaign and various constructive and creative Programmng for the students. Our NSS program officer Sh.Roshan Lal has been declared the best Programme Officer of the university for the year 2012-13.

### **Career Guidance Bureau**

Bureau of the college organized various programme and lectures which informed the students about various career options available to them in pursuing further studies or for going in jobs.

### **Academic Forum**

The academic Forum of the college tries its best to create a congenial atmosphere conducive to studies where the students may take their problems with the teachers and to organize such Programmes, Workshops, and competitions, lectures etc. on personality development, enhancement of communication skills, Preparing for group discussion and personal interview. The forum organized all such programmers and the students took keen interest in them.

### **Library**

Library is the heart and the soul of any institution. Every effort during the session was made to make it learning centric, up to date and technologically advanced. Nearly

seventy thousand [70000] E-books and three thousand five hundred [3500] E- journals have been subscribed. The automation work of the library has been completed.

### **Network Resource Centre**

Network resource has been working in the college library with five desktops having internet facility for the use of the student and the staff during college hours. The various departments of the college have been provided with computers and internet facility.

### **Health awareness programme**

Health awareness committee of the college sees that the students remain physically fit and active because a sound mind lives in a sound body. Medical check up programme of the students was organized in which about 235 students got themselves medically examined. Medical experts are also invited time to time to make the students aware about health problems & their remedies.

## **Plan of Action chalked out by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Session 2013-14.**

Our college is a premier institution located in socially, economically and educationally backward area. Still it has been able to achieve the results with which the founder of the college set up the institution. The college is committed to the all round development of the students and tries to give maximum exposure so that the students turn out to be wholesome personalities when they leave the college and may be capable of facing any challenges that they face in their lives. Our students have shown extra ordinary performance in sports and extracurricular activities with some students participating in All India and International meets. We have good sport facilities and an auditorium for extracurricular activities. Every efforts is made to encourage the faculties of the college to remain updated in their knowledge and should know the latest developments being taken place in the world of science & technology, For this the college plans to provide Internet facilities with computer in every department.
